- We collect personal information from you, including information your:
 - name
 - contact information
 - location
 - immigration status
 - interactions with us
 - refugee case lawyer
 - country of origin
 - date of birth
- We collect your personal information in order to deliver services to you
- Providing some information to us is optional. If you choose not to enter your contact details, we may be unable to provide a full range of support services to you.
- We do our best to keep your personal information safe by storing it on a password protected database and only allowing our staff and social work students to access this.
- We have no formal relationship with Immigration NZ, and do not pass on any information about you to them, unless you agree to this.
